Metro, the transport network of the West Yorkshire Combined Authority does not run buses or trains. The Combined Authority aims to ensure travel needs are met by paying for additional services which are not commercially viable, such as rural, early morning, late evening and Sunday services.

Timetables may vary during holiday periods and it is advisable to check with MetroLine or the bus company prior to travelling.

What's new in this timetable

Service PR1 Elland Road Park & Ride • Leeds City Centre

A revised route has been introduced. The service now operates as normal route due to re-opening of Leeds Bridge, via Meadow Lane and Bridge End and not via Crown Point Road.

Please note this service will not operate on Saturdays or Sundays when Leeds United are playing a home fixture. There will also be no service after 1820 from Boar Lane during weekday home fixtures.

Service PR2 Temple Green Park & Ride • Leeds City Centre

A revised route has been introduced. The service now operates as normal route due to re-opening of Leeds Bridge, via Meadow Lane and Bridge End and not via Crown Point Road.

When using our bus stations:

- Directional signs and notices are there for your safety, please follow them.

- Follow any safety announcements or directions given out over the bus station public address system.

How to use the bus

- At the stop or shelter please indicate clearly to the bus driver that you intend to get on the bus.
- When you get on the bus please tell the driver where you are going.
- If you can give the exact fare, please do so.
- When you are getting close to the stop where you want to get off please ring the bell once, then stay in your seat until the bus stops.
- Smoking is not allowed on any buses.
- For the safety and security of passengers all bus stations, some bus stops and some buses are fitted with CCTV equipment.
