

First Lanarkshire service changes from Sunday 20 August 2017

Timetable changes will be made to services **18, 201, 241, 254, 255, 263 (Sunday only) and 267.**


The following changes will also be made:

Service 21

Gardenhall, Cathkin and city centre.

The route in Glasgow city centre will be revised.

Buses will start and finish at George Square (Cochrane Street, stop CK) and will no longer serve Wellington Street. The map left shows the new route and bus stops in Glasgow city centre.



Service 227

Whitehill and Little Earnock

Frequency will be revised on the Whitehill to Hamilton Town Centre section from 30 to 60 minutes. No change in frequency on Little Earnock to Hamilton section.

Service 229

Eddlewood and Hamilton

Frequency will be revised from 30 to 60 minutes.



Service 240

Carluke or Pather and city centre.

The section of route between Carluke and Wishaw will be withdrawn. Alternative services are provided by other operators.

At Wishaw all journeys on service 240 will continue to Overtown and will no longer serve Pather which will now be served by service 242. Frequency to/from Overtown and Gowkthrapple increased to every 10 minutes during the day Monday to Friday.

The map left shows the revised route for service 240 in the Wishaw area.

During the day on Saturdays the frequency will be revised from every 10 minutes to every 12 minutes.



Service 242

Maxim or Holytown and Overtown

At Wishaw service 242 will now operate to Pather to replace service 240.

For journeys between Motherwell, Wishaw and Overtown please use service 240.

Service 266

Hamilton and Newmains or Shotts

The frequency during the day Monday to Friday between Hamilton and Newmains will be increased to 6 minutes. A revised timetable will be introduced at other times but no change to overall frequency to Shotts and West Crindledyke.
